#### Angeline Vineyards, Cabernet Sauvignon, California, USA, 2018

Comes with rich notes of fresh boysenberry, rich cassis and a touch of light cocoa. Striking and rich. Pairs well with flank steak and caramelized onions.



#### Honig Vineyards & Winery, Sauvignon Blanc, Napa Valley, USA, 2019

Honig Vineyards & Winery is a small, family owned and operated winery located in Rutherford, the heart of the Napa Valley. This wine is bright and fresh. The flavours and aromas are reminiscent of peaches, lemon curd, white grapefruit, and passion fruit with perfectly balanced notes of citrus, stone fruit. The fullness of the mid-palate is complemented by a crisp, lengthy finish.



#### Angeline Vineyards, Pinot Noir Reserve, Mendocino County, USA, 2018

With a dynamic perspective on the industry, the likewise endless possibilities for innovating operations at his own winery (Martin Ray) are what called Courtney Benham to found Angeline in 1990, and what continues to call him to raise the bar on everyday wines. This wine has notes of juicy red fruit accompanied by hints of baking spices. Fresh, balanced and bright. Pairs well with roast duck and crispy roasted potatoes.



#### Innisfree Cabernet Sauvignon (by Joseph Phelps), Napa Valley, USA, 2017

Joseph Phelps has long been one of Napa Valley's stalwarts. Wine Spectator observed Phelps as 'one of Napa Valley's benchmark Cabernet Sauvignon producers'. This wine is made up of the parcels which remain after blending for Insignia and the Napa Cabernet is finalised.



#### Bodegas Benegas, Benegas Estate Malbec, Mendoza, Argentina, 2018

Bodega Benegas produces high quality wines of different levels but always highlighting a style marked by intensity, optimum ripeness and elegance. This wine has high intensity and structure, with a full body, ripe and sweet tannins. This region has proved to be ideal for high-end malbec wines.



#### Martin Ray Winery, Chardonnay, Sonoma Coast, USA, 2018

The name Martin Ray resonates deeply in the history of California Winemaking. Martin Ray was a pioneer, dedicated to crafting single varietal, region-specific wine from 1943 through 1972 in Saratoga. This particular wine is light and juicy with vibrant acidity to the taste, with well-integrated oak and a touch of vanilla bean.



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### Mount Riley, Pinot Noir, Marlborough, New Zealand 2020

Mount Riley was founded in 1992, when owner John Buchanan decided to leave his job with the second largest winery in New Zealand to go back to his roots. Diversity of clone allowed them to make this complex and complete wine with vibrant, pure fruit character and depth of flavour. Grapes were cold soaked, fermented in small parcels and aged for 7 months in French oak barriques



### Vasse Felix, Filius Cabernet Sauvignon, Margaret River, Australia, 2018

Vasse Felix is Margaret River's founding wine estate and was established in 1967 by regional pioneer Dr Tom Cullity. Bright, deep maroon with a purple tint, this wine is the 'Son of' the Vasse Felix Cabernet Sauvignon. It carries the structure, power and tannins of classic Cabernet in an earlier drinking, succulent style from fruit sourced from each of the Vasse Felix vineyards.



### Tyrrell's Wines, Hunter Valley Semillon, New South Wales, Australia, 2020

Established in 1858 by English immigrant Edward Tyrrell, Tyrrell's Wines is one of Australia's pre-eminent family owned wine companies. This wine is bright, attractive green in colour, the nose shows intense citrus characters. Wonderful length and flavour with the pedigree of the vineyards showing through.



### Vasse Felix, Filius Chardonnay, Margaret River, Australia, 2019

This wine is typified by its bright, elegant fruit, subtle wild complexities, tight structure and fresh acidity, reflecting the vibrancy and purity of this variety in Margaret River. Vasse Felix supports sustainable viticulture, with a low intervention approach that allows the wines to express a true representation of their site.



### Tyrrell's Wines, Hunter Valley Shiraz, New South Wales, Australia, 2018

The Hunter Valley Shiraz was made from grapes grown on some of the top blocks on the Tyrrell's estate and surrounding area. This is a wonderful example of a modern, medium-bodied Hunter Valley Shiraz. The wine is a vibrant purple colour, with a lifted nose that shows red fruits and some spice.



### Vasse Felix, Filius Cabernet Merlot, Margaret River, Australia, 2018

This regional blend incorporates more delicate fruit from each of the Vasse Felix Vineyards. Generous portions of Merlot contribute to a succulent wine with approachable tannins.



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#### Castellari Bergaglio, Gavi di Tassarolo Fornaci, Piedmont, Italy, 2019

Mario Bergaglio, 4th generation of this family owned winery is running the estate with his wife and his son. At an altitude of 300m, the farm and winery of Castellari Bergaglio overlooks the Rovereto area. A delicate floral and fruity bouquet of citrus, peach and green apple from this wine. The palate is dry and refreshing with a hint of bitter almond and can cellar well, developing toasty honeyed notes. A versatile dry white that is particularly well suited to seafood.



#### Georg Muller, Hattenheimer Hassel Riesling Kabinett Grosse Lage, Rheingau, Germany, 2018

This estate is located in the Rheingau, Germany's most reputed wine producing area and founded by Georg Müller at the end of the 19th century. A spectacular wine with highly complex aromas between fruity, herbal and yeasty components. This wine has been fermented slowly and gently for 18 months and bottled 22 months after the harvest. It is dense to the palate with almost infinite length.



#### Boscarelli, Vino Nobile di Montepulciano, Tuscany, Italy, 2016

This estate, founded in 1962 by Egidio Corradi started as a dream: producing a noble wine exalting the aromas and flavors of the land while imparting the elegance he loved. This wine's radiant palate is loaded with finesse, delivering raspberry compote, Marasca cherry, licorice, and Asian spice. Elegant, fine-grained tannins provide the framework while bright acidity keeps it balanced.



#### Marques de Grinon, Caliza, Dominio de Valdepusa, Spain, 2013

This 50 hectares winery is located in Dominio de Valdepusa vineyard in Castilla-La Mancha, at a 1068-foot elevation. Deep purple in colour with ruby reflections, this wine shows alluring notes of blackberries and cassis with undertones of cinnamon and minerality. On the palate, it is beautifully full-bodied and silky with refreshing acidity and flavours that unfold into the long-lasting finish.



#### Domaine Jean Claude Roux, Sauvignon Blanc, Quincy, France, 2020

This small estate owns 22 hectares of which 20 are planted with Cabernet Franc and 2 of Chenin Blanc. This typical soft-textured Sauvignon Blanc from Quincy is attractive, with a nice zing to balance the ripe white fruits. Citrus freshness in the aftertaste gives the wine a lift.



#### Jean Luc Colombo, Crozes Hermitage Brunes Rouge, Rhone, France, 2019

The influential Rhône vintner helped introduce Cornas to the rest of the world, relying on modern techniques in one of France's most traditional wine regions. From the terroir of Crozes-Hermitage, this is a full-bodied wine with a velvety texture, notes of blackberries and spice. Black plum, chocolate and oak flavours. Well-balanced.
