1st Month



Bodegas Benegas, Single Vineyard Malbec, Mendoza, Argentina, 2018

Bodega Benegas produces high quality wines of different levels but always highlighting a style marked by intensity, optimum ripeness and elegance. This wine is 100% Malbec from Finca La Encerrada, Gualtallary, Mendoza and was aged in French oak barrels for 6 months.

2nd Month



Freemark Abbey, Cabernet Sauvignon, Napa Valley, 2016

Freemark Abbey produces distinct single-vineyard wines from two of Napa Valley's most impressive and unique vineyards in the Rutherford appellation - Bosche and Sycamore Cabernet Sauvignon. This 2016 Cabernet Sauvignon reveals a medium to deep purple-red colour with hints of fresh black plums, blackberries, blackcurrants and dark chocolate.

3rd Month



Cakebread Cellars, Chardonnay, Napa Valley, 2019

Since the founding of the winery in 1973, Cakebread Cellars has focused on making fine Napa Valley wines. This Chardonnay opens with aromas of ripe golden apple, white peach, and notes of oak. This is a versatile food-pairing wine—we love it with fresh salads, grilled scallops, and nearly any selection of cheeses.



Joseph Phelps, Pinot Noir, Sonoma Coast Freestone Vineyard, 2018

Joseph Phelps has long been one of Napa Valley's stalwarts. The 2018 Pinot Noir highlights fragrant violet, rustic baking spices and cedar notes followed by juicy raspberry, black cherry and hints of red currant. Focused and youthful with a lifting acid length, black pepper spice and orange peel.



Cakebread Cellars, Sauvignon Blanc, Napa Valley, 2019

The sauvignon blanc grapes are selected from the best growing spots in Napa Valley, including the estate ranches in Carneros, Suscol Springs, Rutherford, and Calistoga. Cool night time harvest, whole-cluster press, and a variety of fermentation vessels—stainless steel tanks, neutral French oak barrels, and a concrete egg—enhance the complexity of this bright, crisp, mineral-driven wine.



Vina Cobos, Corcodrilo, Mendoza, Argentina, 2017

Viña Cobos makes wines that are authentic expressions of their terroir. In this wine you will sense notes of fresh plums, blueberries, dark chocolate and sweet spices. With a deep ruby red colour, this is a full-bodied wine with fine-grained tannins.

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Henschke, Henry's Seven Barossa Shiraz Grenache, Eden Valley, Australia, 2018

Henschke is one of Australia's leading winemakers. It is recognised for its rich heritage, innovative spirit and commitment to handcrafting exceptional wines for 150 years. Deep crimson with ruby hues. Attractive aromas of spiced plum, red currant and blue and black berry fruits are met with floral nuances of violets and black pepper spice.



Rockford, Moppa Springs Grenache Shiraz Mataro, Barossa Valley, Australia, 2017

Rockford wines are made from established Barossa varieties such as Shiraz, Riesling, Semillon and Grenache in a style that best reflects the vineyards, the winemaker's attitude and the climate in which we live. When the final blend comes together with this wine you will feel layers of soft, savoury, spicy flavours.



Henschke, Innes Vineyard Pinot Gris, Adelaide Hills, Australia, 2020

The Adelaide Hills has an altitude ranging from 400-600m and a rainfall of around 700-1000mm. Soils consist of sandy loam overlying weathered shale and clay, which provide excellent conditions for viticulture. This wine comes with flavours of nashi pear, white currant and nectarine, supported by crisp acidity and balanced by a creamy, textural quality with a hint of anise spice, giving it a lovely, lingering finish.



Vasse Felix, Cabernet Sauvignon, Margaret River, Australia, 2017

The signature Cabernet Sauvignon of Vasse Felix. It was the first red wine produced in Margaret River and has been made every year since 1972. This wine's distinctive style possesses all the hallmarks of the finest Wilyabrup Cabernet. This is an elegant but powerful wine.



Mt Beautiful, Pinot Noir, North Canterbury, New Zealand, 2018

Mount Beautiful estate is located on the eastern side of the South Island between Marlborough and Waipara. As a personal favourite of Mt. Beautiful's owner David Teece, it's incredibly important for the Pinot Noir to showcase the best aspects of the varietal. Subtlety is the secret inside this wine. It begins with sophisticated floral fragrances of sweet spice and ripe soft red berry fruits, while showcasing an elegant medium-weight palate that features fragrant strawberry and bramble fruit, earthiness and subtle tannins.



Vasse Felix, Heytsbury Chardonnay, Margaret River, Australia, 2017

One of the ICON wines of the vineyard, it comes from unique small vineyard sections where clone, aspect and soil interplay in such a way to ignite stunning varietal and wild yeast characters. With bright, light golden straw colours, this wine comes with elegant, fragrant notes of hazelnut, mealy wafer and brioche that intertwine with grapefruit, hints of fine lemon pith and honey dew melon.

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Ca' del Baio, Barbaresco Autinbej, Piedmont, Italy, 2016

For 4 generations Ca' del Baio has been a family affair, as is the tradition in the Langhe. Today the Ca' del Baio estate takes in 28 hectares of vineyards in Barbaresco and Treiso. The Barbaresco Autinbej has a garnet red colour and intense fruity, spicy and even balsamic aromas. On the palate it is characterized by a pleasant juiciness, but also by harmony and structure. Finely woven tannins and a long, slightly spicy finish complete the picture.



Chateau Fuisse, Pouilly Fuisse Tete de Cuvee, Maconnais, France, 2018

The Château de Fuissé's vineyards, located in southern Burgundy, cover more than 40 hectares spanning five appellations. With a medium lemon-green colour, on the nose this wine is ripe with stone and tropical fruits, honeysuckle, white pepper, cream and cloves. On the palate it is dry, the flavours are like the aromas, with high acidity, full body and a long peach-spice aftertaste.



Georg Muller, Assmannshauer Frankenthal Spatburgunder Troken Erste Lage, Rheingau, Germany 2017

The single vineyard is located in the district of the Rheingau municipality of Assmannshausen, which has always been known for its special, distinctive Pinot Noirs. This wine is a strong cherry red with fine, violet reflections on the edges, with a clear and strong colour. A variety of aromas flow into the nose, from dark cherry, blackberry, wild strawberry to notes of essential oils and herbs to forest soil and black pepper. Food pairing with duck in plum sauce with sugar snap peas and bell beans.



Georg Muller, Hattenheimer Hassel Riesling GG Gross Lage, Rheingau, Germany, 2017

This estate is located in the Rheingau, Germany's most reputed wine producing area and founded by Georg Müller at the end of the 19th century. The wine has a clear, golden and radiant feel in the glass. Subtle aromas of Rooibos tea and fresh lime are the first nuances that flow into the nose, followed by aromas of juicy and ripe pear and apple. Pair with lamb shanks with baked pumpkin.



Dominio de Atauta, Dominio de Atauta, Ribera del Duero, Spain, 2016

Dominio de Atauta is located in a valley at 1000m above sea level in Atauta, a village in Soria, with very particular oenological characteristics. Inviting plum and berry aromas are supported by oak and dusty earth notes in this wine. While this is ripe (15% abv) and generous on the palate, it has a healthy blend of grainy tannins and acidity. Oak-aided berry flavours run long on the finish.



Pieropan, Amarone della Valpolicella, Veneto, Italy, 2015

For over a century, the Pieropan family has revolutionized winemaking in Soave, becoming one of the most acclaimed Italian wine families. This wine comes with a heady perfume of black cherries and red summer fruits with notes of pepper and sweet spice. On the palate it is complex and rounded, with a powerful structure supporting the fruit and a lovely freshness on the finish. A wine with plenty of character with the potential to age well.
