### Luna Benegas Cabernet Sauvignon, Mendoza, Argentina, 2018 x 3

The Benegas Family was deeply linked to the wine industry development in Argentina. All the grapes used to make the wines are sourced from their own vineyards Finca Libertad and Finca La Encerrada. This ensures the style and quality, while expressing the terroir of the estates. This wine has a deep ruby colour and on the nose presents intense aromas of black fruits, green pepper and notes of pepper. It has excellent balance with ripe tannins and a pleasant, long finish. Can be paired with rich meat dishes such as beef stew, pot roast, grilled veal or lamb.



### Carmela Benegas Cabernet Franc Rose, Mendoza, Argentina, 2020 x 3

Bodega Benegas' two vineyards have distinct characteristics: ungrafted old vines in Finca Libertad and high-altitude vineyards in Finca La Encerrada. This wine has elegant notes of white peach, pineapple and white flowers which grants body, structure and softness. This wine has a soft cherry red colour and comes with red fresh fruit aromas on the nose. Fresh and delicate on the palate, there is a beautiful balance between fruit and alcohol. Long finish with typical cabernet franc notes.

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### Vina Cobos Felino Malbec, Mendoza, Argentina, 2020 x 3

All of Viña Cobos' wines are crafted through meticulous work in the vineyards and winery, so that year-after-year the wines faithfully express the essence of each variety and terroir. With a royal purple colour, this wine is expressive on the nose with notes of violet flowers and shortbread. On the palate, there are vibrant flavours of blueberry and jam, with ripe tannins.



### Vina Cobos Felino Chardonnay, Mendoza, Argentina, 2018 x 3

Paul Hobbs, founding partner and winemaker at Viña Cobos, has worked since 1988 in the exploration of the different terroirs of Mendoza, looking for the most distinguished regions in Luján de Cuyo and the Valle de Uco, to produce wines that uniquely express their origins. This wine is a yellow colour and fruity on the nose with tropical fruit aromas of mango, pineapple and citrus. On the palate, you will find flavours of green apple, peach, and a subtle hint of vanilla.



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### Juan Benegas Malbec, Mendoza, Argentina, 2019 x 3

Bodega Benegas' wines have six main attributes: intense fruit flavors and aromas, with a supple body, ripe tannins, balanced acidity, a long and lingering finish and, the fruit is never overpowered by the oak treatments. This wine has an intense cherry red colour with violet hues. On the nose there is fresh red fruit and some typical spicy notes of the Mendoza First Zone and flowers from the Uco Valley. The wood ageing grants some notes of vanilla and caramel. On the palate there is sweet tannins that balance well with the fresh fruit and acidity.



### Clara Benegas Chardonnay, Mendoza, Argentina, 2019 x 3

The winery is in Luján de Cuyo, Province of Mendoza, 20 minutes from the city of Mendoza. The Province of Mendoza is in the center-west of Argentina, on the border with Chile, at the foot of the Andes Mountain Range and produces about 70% of Argentine wines. This wine is refreshing on the palate, exhibiting a delicate structure in the middle mouth where this wine reaches its maximum expression. Long and lingering finish.
