Chateau La Clare, Medoc, Bordeaux, Bordeaux, France, 2014 x 2

A bold, rustic wine, the 2014 Le Clare delivers considerable quality for the money. Smoke, tobacco, game and wild black cherries add nuance. This hearty, full-bodied Médoc is a solid choice for drinking over the next handful of years.



Clos Canarelli Rouge, Corse Figari, Corsica, France, 2016 x 2

At the foot of the Omu di Cagna (mountain which culminates at 1215m), the Figari vineyard offers powerful, racy and extremely fine wines. This wine is made wih an assemblage of niellucciu (80%), sciaccarellu, black carcagholu and syrah. Black fruit nose, smoky and wild notes.



Clos Canarelli White, Corse Figari, Corsica, France, 2017 x 2

The winemaker maintains permanent tactile contact with the fruit, which he compares and selects for the highest quality result. The estate has been certified organic since 2002 and biodynamic since 2006. This wine is 100% Vermentinu with white flowers on the nose and lemony notes. The mouth is full, with mineral notes.



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Chateau de Chamirey Mercurey Blanc, Mercurey, Bourgogne, France, 2015 x 2

The Domaine of Château de Chamirey, planted in the best terroirs of Mercurey, consists of 37 hectares including 6 big plots of Premier Cru in the village of Mercurey which is almost half the agricultural area of the village. The wine comes with a lightly gold colour and is well-balanced and floral on the nose with white fruits aromas as white peach. The palate is full and rich at the beginning. The wine is very tasty and nicely balanced.



Chateau Saint Georges, Saint-Emillon, Bordeaux, France, 2012 x 2

Owned by the Petrus Desbois family since 1891, 'Chateau Saint-Georges' is the premier label. The 2012 vintage is medium-bodied and has notes of damp earth, black currants and black cherries.



BriO de Cantenac Brown, Margaux, Bordeaux, France, 2009 x 2

The colour is rich and deep, with purple and crimson shades. The nose is an explosion of smooth and fruity aromas with slightly wooded notes. On the palate, softness prevails: fresh fruits, cocoa and fine tannins with great elegance. Like all great vintages, 2009 can age for a few more years.



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Thibault Liger-Belair Moulin -a-Vent, 'Les vieilles vignes', Beaujolais, France, 2017 x 2

Each appellation of the Domaine is worked in a dfferent way according to the soil and their climatic condition. This wine is a blend that offers great density on the front of the palate, followed by good length as a result of the shallow and mineral soil. Can be enjoyed with veal, pork and pasta.



Domaine Bernard Gripa, Saint-Joseph, Rhone, France, 2017 x 2

The Gripa family has a long history in the village and their generations of family winemaking traditions are key to the operations of the Domaine today. The 2017 vintage has depth on the palate with flavours of black cherries, liquorice and hints of black olive and grilled meat with fine-grained tannins.



Domaine Comte Peraldi - Cuvee du Cardinal, Ajaccio, Corsica, France, 2013 x 2

Since this estate began in 1965, the philosophy has always been to seek the best quality; selecting the ideal sites for grapegrowing in a careful and eco-friendy viticulture. Our emblematic variety, sciaccarello, is at its highest quality in this barrel-aged wine, with great complexity, deep concentration, excellent balance, and a potential to age up to 20 years.
